

ST FAITH`S MID-SUMMER PARTY

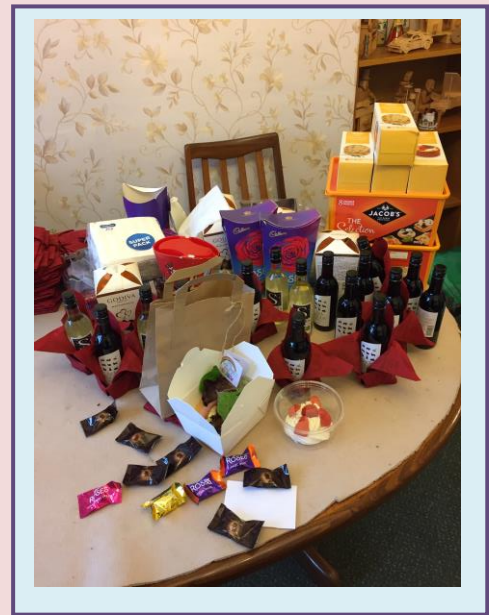
Despite the continuing coronavirus lockdown Rosie and Rick spent their time constructively and organised a second party for the people of St Faith`s
