In church you will find over 30 individual Christmas Trees decorated and lit.

Each has been sponsored by a local or national charity, and you are invited to contribute to as many as you wish.

Throughout the week, light refreshments will be on sale - lunches, afternoon tea, coffee and cakes.

There are gift stalls - including the products of St Faith's Jam Factory, craft stalls and a pre-loved stall for you to browse and pick up bargains, and musical entertainment from local schools and our famous busker's organ.

There is a splendid (free!) military band carol concert on Wednesday evening
and a (ticketed) gala concert on Friday evening.

Daily admission to the Festival is **FREE**, so come along, stroll around,
soak up the atmosphere or just rest your feet awhile!

SUNDAY DECEMBER 2nd

The day begins with our Toy Service and Church Parade at 11.00 am.

Following this, the Festival is open until 5.00 pm. Tea and cakes will be on sale, and stalls open.

WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 5th

We open at 12 noon for lunches, afternoon teas, coffee and cakes and all the sales stalls, and close at 5.00 pm

We open again at 7.00pm for you to come and hear our famous Military Brass Band carol concert,
joined this year by the Broadgreen Hospital Choir..

The band strikes up at 7.30pm - admission is FREE, with a retiring collection for forces' charities

THURSDAY DECEMBER 6th

We open at 12 noon for lunches, afternoon teas, coffee and cakes and all the sales stalls, and close at 5.00 pm

FRIDAY DECEMBER 7th

We open at 12 noon for lunches, afternoon teas, coffee and cakes and all the sales stalls, and close at 5.00 pm

We open again for this evening's gala concert, which features St Nicholas' Community Singers, the Wayfarers' Chorus and soprano Danielle Louise Thomas. The concert begins at 7.30 pm. Admission (for this event only) £8 on the door: ticket includes interval tea, coffee and biscuits (and wine on sale!)

SATURDAY DECEMBER 8th

We open today at 10.00 am for lunches, afternoon teas, coffee and cakes and all the sales stalls,
and close (until next year!) at 4.00 pm

SUNDAY DECEMBER 9th

If you missed all the other openings or would just like to say farewell to the trees,
they will still be in place during our usual Sung Eucharist at 11.00 am, before it all gets dismantled.
